How do I enrol?

Simply register your interest and fill in the online pre-enrolment form here: <https://www.thefashioninstitute.com.au/pre-enrolment-application>. We require a \$1,000 AUD deposit to secure your place, which will be refunded to your nominated bank account once your FEE HELP is approved.

Will Internships and Work Experience still be arranged for me?

Our Careers Manager will continue to offer you quality and tailored experiences throughout your studies. Students will continue to be notified when new experiences become available. All students are guaranteed 1 x internship at the end of each year throughout their studies.

How many days per week of study?

2 x days weekly on-campus with additional online study + research.

When do enrolments open and close?

Enrolments are currently open to study for February and May 2022. Enrolments are filling up quickly, therefore we do suggest getting your enrolment form and deposit in ASAP.

Enrolments for our February 2022 are closing 30 September 2021.

Can I pay for the course privately instead of using FEE HELP?

Yes. You can either pay for the course upfront or utilise Study Loans. FEE-HELP is a loan scheme that helps eligible Australian fee-paying students (full-time or part-time) pay their tuition fees.

FEE-HELP can cover all or part of your tuition fees. Students make repayments on their loan through the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) once their income is above the threshold, or voluntary repayment to ATO can be made at any time.

No interest is charged on FEE-HELP loans, however, the Commonwealth Government applies a one off loan fee and it is indexed each year with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) in line with the cost of living.

How many electives do I get to choose?

All students will have the opportunity to select 2 of the 5 electives offered.

What will the class dynamic look like?

What happens if I enrol, and need to terminate my studies?

All students have the opportunity to terminate their enrolment completely up until a week before your selected course date kicks off. Alternatively, students are welcome to defer their studies.

You will only be charged for the units you have completed.

What's the difference in online vs on-campus study?

For online students, the Bachelor will be structured in actual class hours with a qualified trainer. Therefore there is no self-study option.
